



IT Assessments for Your Organization

Leverage IT assessments to underline gaps and highlight capabilities that drive value from your IT department. Below is a sample of IT assessments that are currently popular in the market.

- 1 Business Alignment**
Assesses the Information Technology strategic plan and roadmap to validate the alignment with the business goals and objectives of an organization
- 2 Business Value**
Measures the perceived value that an IT organization delivers through the eyes of business stakeholders
- 3 IT Governance and Management**
Evaluates the quality and comprehensiveness of the IT Governance framework and supporting policies and procedures
- 4 Information Protection**
Evaluates the overall information protection program in place in an organization to safeguard data
- 5 Service Management**
Determines your current overall service management maturity level, as well as percentage of completeness for individual Service Management processes [1]
- 6 IT Security**
Identifies IT security vulnerabilities and risks
- 7 IT Staffing**
Assesses whether an IT organization has the right number of resources with appropriate skill sets to successfully achieve the goals and objectives of the IT organization
- 8 Data Quality (DQA)**
Scientifically and statistically evaluates data in order to determine whether they meet the quality required for projects or business processes and are they able to support their intended use [2]
- 9 Vendor Risk**
Uncovers the risks that exist when using a vendor's product or service
- 10 Project Management Office (PMO)**
Assesses a PMOs capabilities and maturity level
- 11 Application Portfolio Rationalization**
Strategically identify business applications across an organization to determine which applications should be kept, replaced, retired, or consolidated [3]
