organizations fail to achieve the benefits of digital modernization

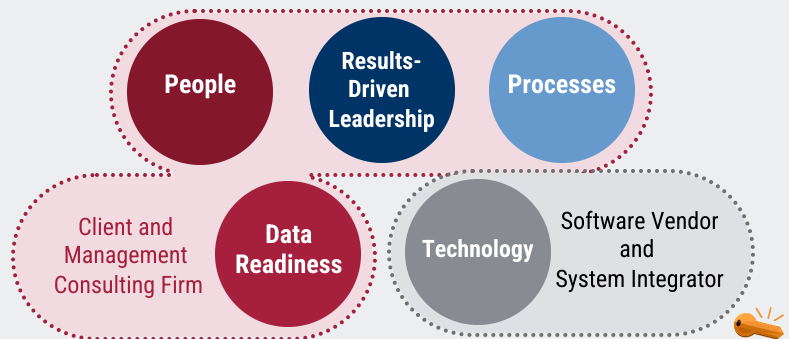
- 1** Organizations overemphasize new technology features, functions and implementation thinking that will solve all their problems.
- 2** Organizations lack significant digital modernization experience and methodology, leading to too much reliance on technology vendors.
- 3** End users are not adequately prepared to use the new technology efficiently and effectively, which leads to poor end-user adoption.
- 4** Current processes are not adapted to take advantage of the new technology leading to inefficient processes and unnecessary software customizations.

5 Pillars of Digital Modernization

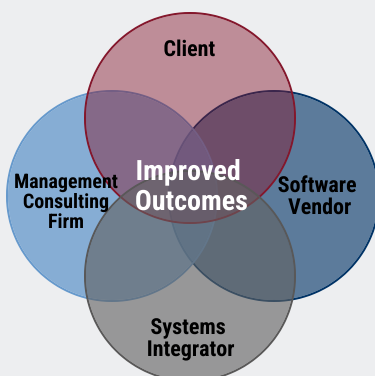

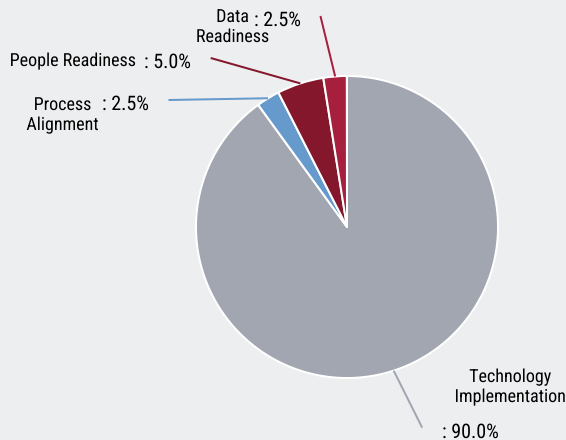

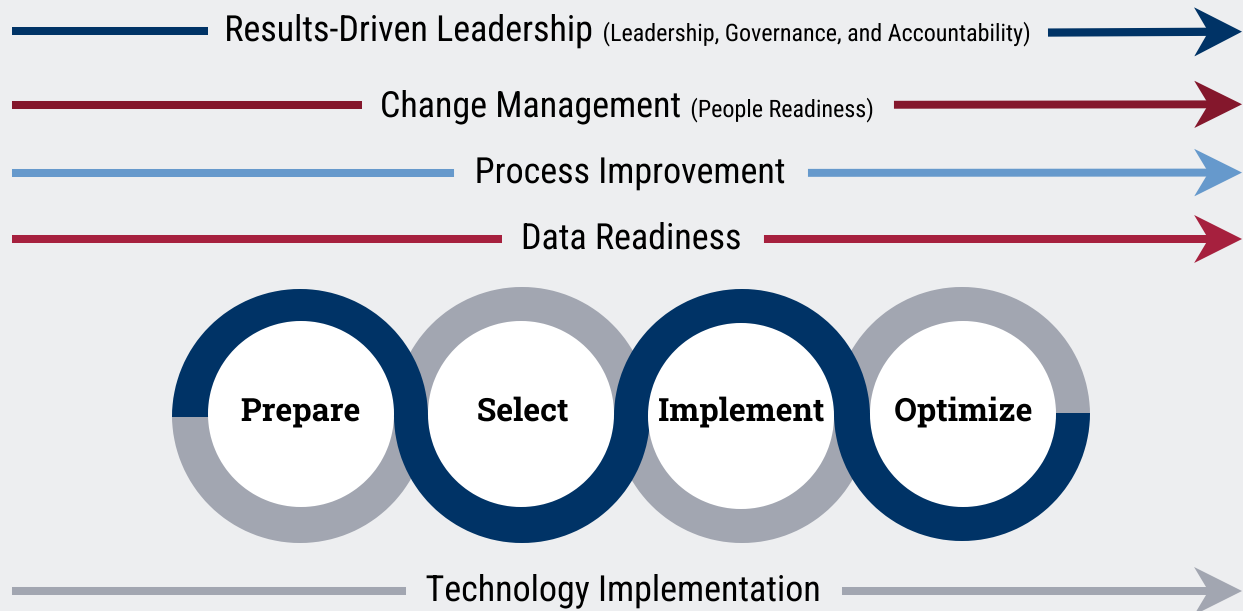

Keys to Successful Digital Modernization

- ➔ Clearly define desired performance improvements and align people, processes, and the new technology to achieve them (just implementing new technology should not be considered a success).
- ➔ Understand each party's roles and responsibilities and assess internal experience and capabilities to determine where outside assistance is required.
- ➔ Establish an appropriate budget (financial and people) for the scope of the modernization and allocate the budget to achieve alignment of people, processes, and technology.
- ➔ If outside services are required the best practice would be to buy in phases.
